Are you a motivated and talented graduate-level student looking for hands-on experience in international development? IAS Denmark is currently seeking three interns to join our program team in Copenhagen NV. We are a faith-based organization committed to empowering self-help opportunities and providing people with dignity through transformative initiatives that go beyond emergency relief and development aid.

If you have a background in fields like Global Development, Africa Studies, Education, Social Studies, CBS, Theology, or IT Management, and are willing to work in a smaller organization, we encourage you to apply!

The potential Internship Positions are (we plan to hire three of the following profiles):

1. A “Climate Change Adaptation” Intern

Help prepare a new Climate Change Adaptation Project in Tharaka, Kenya.

2. MEAL and Inclusive Education Intern

Assist in the dissemination of data from our Inclusive Education Program and prepare for our upcoming review.

3. “Core Humanitarian Standard Verification Process” Intern

Work on preparing documentation for IAS Denmark and our African partner organizations to comply with CHS standards as we seek to become CHS verified.

4. “Pentecostalism as Development Agent” Intern

Analyze Danish and Global Pentecostal Church Partners and their development programs through data collection, profiling, and segmentation.

5. Introduction of Microsoft Project as a Management Tool Intern

Help strengthen our project management IT tools, for example, with the introduction of Microsoft Project to the Program Team and organization.

6. A “Development of private sector partnerships” intern

Explore opportunities for collaboration with private Danish companies, prepare partnership agreements and develop an application for Danida Green Business Partnership (DGBP)

Duration

Four months, 30 hours weekly (or full-time) Location: Nordvest, Copenhagen, Denmark, with potential travel opportunities to East Africa.

Responsibilities (vary by position)

- Conduct research and analyze data to inform project design and implementation.
- Assist in the development of project proposals, reports, and other relevant documentation.
- Coordinate with internal and external stakeholders to ensure project success.
- Support the planning and organization of workshops, trainings, and events.
- Monitor and evaluate project progress and contribute to continuous improvement efforts.
- Assist with communications, including social media and website updates.
- Travel to visit our partners in Africa.

Qualifications

- Currently enrolled in or recently completed a graduate program and taking time off to be an intern.
- Good research, analytical, and problem-solving skills.
- Clear written and verbal communication abilities in English
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a dynamic environment.
- Commitment to IAS Denmark’s mission and values.
- Proficiency in English and preferably Danish
